





Last term Year 2-6 did a waste audit on 3 school bins around the school.


Year 2, 3 and 4 emptied a Year 4 bin and a Year 3 bin and looked at what was thrown away.



The green team have set up an account with Re-collect, who provide the Container Deposit Scheme Bins. These bins will help our school reduce the amount of containers that we are sending to landfill.








They had student and staff volunteers get inside and sing a song, then the assembly had to guess who it was.





Re-collect - The Green Team

Our Primary School has successfully reduced its landfill impact by making use of the six Recollect Bins that are placed throughout our playgrounds. These bins were introduced to our school by our Green Team students after they discovered how many of our drink containers were entering our landfill bins from canteen orders or drink containers brought from home. These bins have been in place since Term 3 this year, and our Primary Students and (staff members) are working hard at changing their behaviours by using these bins at break times. So far, we have collected over 1000 containers, and plan to collect at least this many during Term 4.

The central purpose of these bins is to minimise our impact on landfill, but the Green Team are also raising money to purchase compost cones for our playgrounds.
